

The Fulbright Program is an international educational exchange program established by the U.S. Congress in 1946 under legislation introduced by the late Senator J. William Fulbright. It was established through an executive agreement signed by representatives of the governments of the Philippines and the United States.

The Philippine-American Educational Foundation (PAEF) is a non-profit, bi-national organization. Since 1948, PAEF has administered the Fulbright program (its flagship program), the Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship, and other educational exchange initiatives which seek to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the Philippines. Currently, PAEF boasts itself as the longest continuously-running Fulbright Commission in the world, and the oldest international scholarship in the Philippines.

Fulbright Graduate Student Program (Classic)

Scholarships for Filipinos to study at the graduate level (Master's or Doctoral studies) or pursue non-degree doctoral enrichment or doctoral dissertation research in the United States.

Open to all fields except medicine and health-related fields, and accounting.

Fulbright Advanced Research and University Lecturing (Senior Scholar) Program

Fellowships to Filipino academics and professionals to lecture and/or conduct research in the United States. *Open to all fields except medicine and health-related fields, and accounting.*

Fulbright U.S. - ASEAN Visiting Scholar Program

Fellowships for university faculty, government officials, and professional staff of think tanks and other NGOs in ASEAN member nations to travel to the U.S. for scholarly and professional research for three to four months on issues that are relevant and useful to member nations, and central to the U.S. - ASEAN relationship.

Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program

For all Filipino English teachers based outside of Metro Manila. FLTAs have the opportunity to spend one academic year sharing their culture and language with American students.

Fulbright Distinguished Awards in Teaching Program for International Teachers (Fulbright DAI)

A semester-long non-degree, non-credit, professional development program at a U.S. university for Filipino primary and secondary school faculty and staff.

Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program

Established in honor of the late U.S. Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey, awards for mid-career professionals for ten months of combined non-degree studies and related practical and professional experiences. The program develops leaders who will have a "multiplier effect" on society.

Global Undergraduate (Global UGRAD) Exchange Program

Scholarships for Filipino non-graduating college students to participate in a semester-long non-degree academic study at an assigned U.S. college or university. Participants are emerging leaders committed to their home communities.

Fulbright Student Program

For U.S. graduate students and graduating senior students to conduct research and study in the Philippines.

Fulbright Senior Scholar Program

For U.S. academics and professionals to do lecturing or research, or a combination of both, in the Philippines.

Fulbright Specialist Program

For U.S. faculty and professionals to pursue short-term academic opportunities at host institutions in the Philippines.

Fulbright Distinguished Awards in Teaching Short-Term (DAST) Program

For U.S. educators to engage in collaborative projects for 2-6 weeks with a Philippine institution.
