Resolution No. 1377

WHEREAS, Article IV, Part III of the Integrated Reorganization Plan, as approved by Presidential Decree No. 1, as amended, dated 24 September 1972, created the Career Executive Service Board (CESB) to serve as the governing body of the Career Executive Service (CES) with the mandate to promulgate policies, rules, guidelines, standards, systems and processes for the recruitment, selection, classification, compensation, placement and the leadership, professional and career development of members of the CES;

WHEREAS, the Board, through CES Board Resolution No. 882 enacted on 13 July 2010, promulgated and institutionalized the CES Accreditation and Equivalency System (CESAES) for the purpose of promoting and sustaining continuing professional growth, self-development and capacity strengthening of CESOs and third level eligibles in a purposive, effective, systematic and efficient manner;

WHEREAS, the CESAES empowers and enables the Board to formulate, prescribe, implement and manage a system of policies, guidelines, standards, systems, processes and tools which constitute the parameters and mechanisms for:

- 1) Evaluating, establishing the equivalency of, and recognizing leadership, personal/professional development and management capability building programs for CESOs and third level eligibles; and
- 2) Granting accreditation (re-accreditation) to the said training programs and to institutions engaged in the development and delivery of the said programs;

WHEREAS, the Human Resource Innovations and Solutions, Inc. (HURIS), a Philippine-based institutional education and training program/service provider has been conducting training programs/workshop courses as public course offerings consistently preferred and promoted by various private and public sector institutions for the capacity enhancement of their technical personnel, supervisors and executive-level managers and to achieve organizational performance effectiveness;

WHEREAS, HURIS has applied for the accreditation of "Driving Execution (How to Get Things Done)" and "Building Powerful Teams;"

WHEREAS, HURIS has paid the accreditation fee of Php 10,000.00 each for the accreditation of two training programs/courses - "Driving Execution (How to Get Things Done)" and "Building Powerful Teams" on 18 September 2017;

WHEREAS, after complete and diligent review and evaluation by the Board, the abovementioned requirements have been found to have substantially and satisfactorily complied with all applicable terms, conditions and requirements stipulated in the CESAES for the grant of accreditation status;

NOW THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, the Board resolves, as it is hereby resolved, to **APPROVE** the accreditation of "**Driving Execution (How to Get Things Done)**" and "**Building Powerful Teams**" commencing on 31 October 2017 until 30 October 2020 subject to applicable terms as prescribed by the CESAES.


