AUTHORIZING THE CAREER EXECUTIVE SERVICE (CES) GOVERNING BOARD CHAIRPERSON TO ENTER INTO THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE PRESIDENTIAL ANTI-CORRUPTION COMMISSION (PACC)

RESOLUTION NO. 1463

WHEREAS, the PACC is vested by Executive Order Number 43, Series of 2017 with the power, on complaint or *motu proprio*, and concurrently with the Office of the Ombudsman, to hear, investigate, receive, gather and evaluate evidence, intelligence reports, and information in administrative cases against all presidential appointees in the Executive Branch of the government and any of its agencies or instrumentalities occupying the position of Assistant Regional Director or an equivalent rank and higher, among other officials, for acts or omissions constituting violations of: (1) RA 3019, as amended; (2) RA 1379 on the unlawful acquisition of property by a public officer or employee; (3) RA 6713; (4) provisions under Title Seven, Book Two of the Revised Penal Code; (5) EO 292, whenever it defines and imposes administrative sanctions on acts and omissions constituting violations of the foregoing laws and issuances; (6) rules and regulations duly promulgated by competent authority to implement any of the foregoing laws and issuances; and (7) other violations as may be referred to the Commission by the President;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its functions, the PACC may call upon all government agencies and instrumentalities for assistance and cooperation for acquisition of documents pertinent to its investigation or to participate in or conduct the investigation, as well as issue subpoena ad testificandum and duces tecum;

WHEREAS, the Integrated Reorganization Plan (IRP) authorizes the Career Executive Service (CES) Governing Board to promulgate rules, standards and procedures on the selection, classification, compensation and career development of members of the CES;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its functions, the CESB receives and issues documents pertinent to the selection, classification, compensation, and career development of incumbents of CES positions, whether Career Executive Service Officers (CESOs), third level eligibles, or non-eligibles;

WHEREAS, a Cooperation Agreement between CESB and the PACC whereby the CESB will provide documents specified hereunder upon request of the PACC will aid the CESB in ensuring that members of the CES are well-selected and development-oriented career administrators who are of unquestionable integrity and who shall provide competent and faithful service;

WHEREAS, the agreement will likewise aid the PACC in the fulfillment of its mandate of

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assisting the President in investigating and/or hearing administrative cases primarily involving graft and corruption against all presidential appointees;

WHEREAS, the Cooperation Agreement shall take effect upon signing by the parties and shall remain in force unless sooner terminated by mutual consent of the parties; and

WHEREFORE, the aforementioned premises considered, the Board RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to authorize CES Governing Board Chairperson Alicia dela Rosa-Bala to represent and to-act for or in behalf of the Board, and with the power to sign, execute and deliver the Cooperation Agreement including certificates as may be required, and to perform any other act as may be necessary or appropriate to effect the foregoing.
